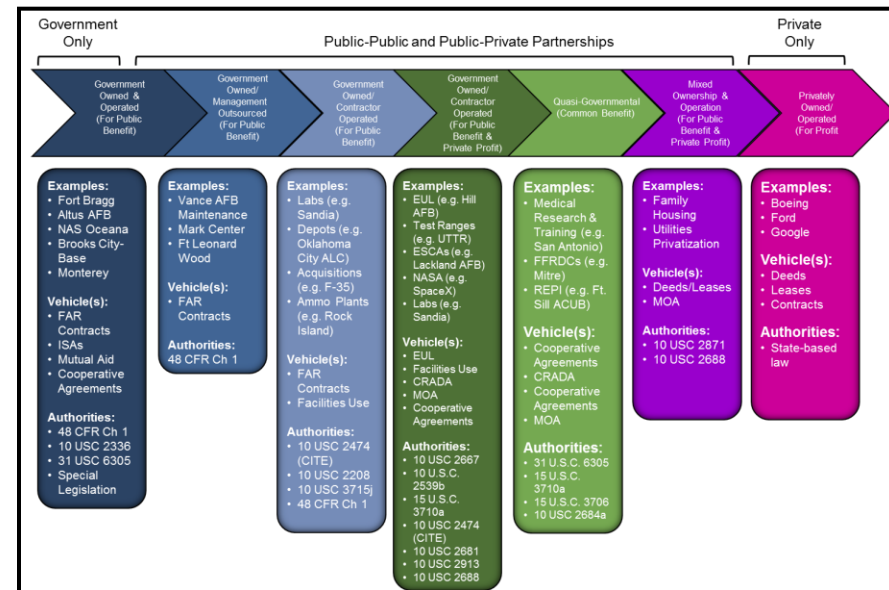

What is P4?

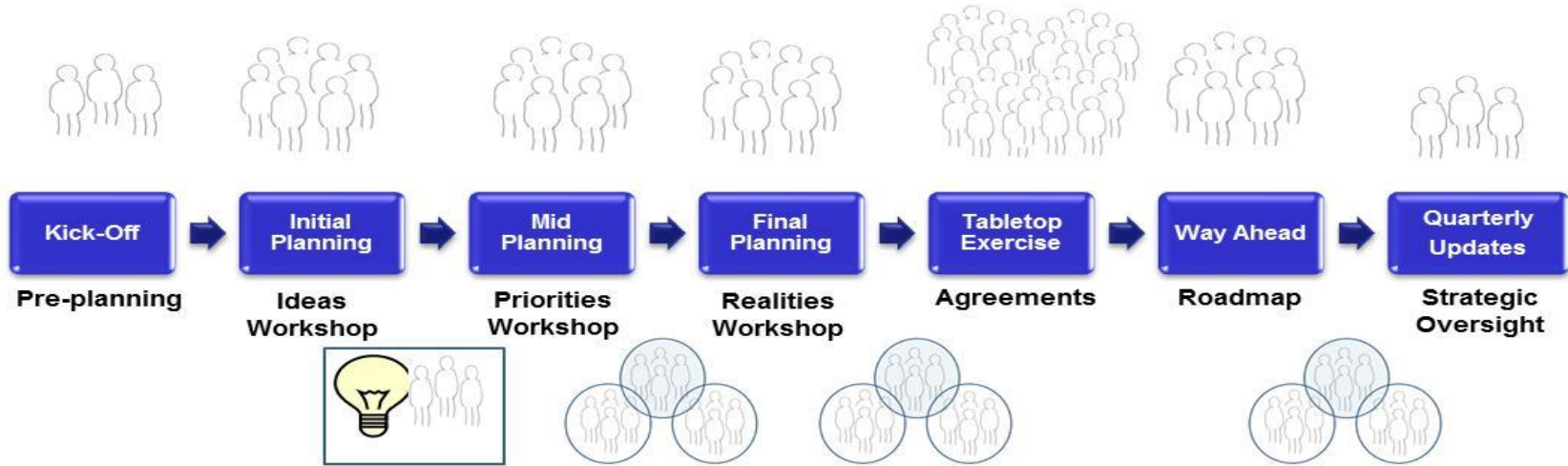

 - Short-term use of city jail (Tinker AFB)
 - FEMA facility rental (Ellsworth AFB)
